
THE PROGRAM

The 3 Modules of the CoBS Advanced International Certificate




- **Build and develop your own company** taking into account sustainability and CSR variables via a challenging business simulation (module 1).
- Study practical and relevant online modules crafted by leading international faculty from the CoBS providing global, regional and local contexts and issues in responsible business practices (module 2).
- Participate in lectures and coaching sessions delivered by a subject matter expert and top faculty researcher (modules 1-3).
- **Discover a territory of high complexity and relevance to the SDGs,** particularly those relating to climate change and biodiversity the Amazon (module 3).
- Visit and open dialogue with a diversity of leaders including indigenous, riverine, women's cooperative and business leaders (module 3).

Students earn 1 CoBS Responsible Leadership Certificate per module. Students completing all 3 modules will receive a CoBS Full Advanced International Certificate.



THE PROGRAM: MODULE 1



1. BUSINESS & SUSTAINABILITY SIMULATION: 22ND-25TH APRIL, 2025

- Taking into account sustainability variables, build and develop your company in a competition that pitches you against other master's and MBA student teams from the schools of the Council on Business & Society.
- 2.5 days introduction to the scenario and simulation, practice against the computer, coaching and feedback from CoBS faculty
- In teams: 2.5 days in competition mode from 24th-25th April, competing against other teams in the CoBS student cohort, adjudication by a jury including business change makers.
- €1,500 prize money for the winning team plus certificates for all participants.



2. ONLINE MODULES: JUNE 1ST-30TH, 2025

- Follow 3 online modules depending on your knowledge gaps, areas of interest, and career aspirations. Modules are CSR, ESG, and Sustainability-focused. Each one has been developed by a leading faculty-research member of a CoBS member school and based on the "CoBS 3 Pillars of Responsible Leadership": Ethical Leadership, Responsible Governance, Measuring and Guiding Impact. Total online time: 3 hours video time to be followed when you want, where you want.
- One online live lecture of 1 hour: Date and time to be determined.
- · Certificate of completion.

3. INTERNATIONAL INTENSIVE WEEK: JUNE 30TH - JULY 5TH, 2025 THE FGV EAESP-CoBS INTENSIVE PROGRAM 2025

For MBA students and master's students with work/internship experience

- This UN PRME award-winning learning experience focuses on the theme of *Sustainable Leadership: The rainforest perspective*.
- A week's intensive organised by FGV-EAESP onboard a riverboat in the Amazon.
- Taking students to a territory of high complexity and relevance to the SDGs, particularly those relating to climate change and biodiversity the Amazon.
- It includes field trips and meetings with indigenous, riverine, and women's co-operative leaders among others.
- Upon completion, students will be delivered a double certificate FGV EAESP and CoBS Responsible Leadership Certificate.
- Students completing the full learning path of 3 modules will earn the Advanced International Certificate featuring the FGV EAESP logo, your home school logo, and the Council on Business & Society member schools banner.

Note: Students will ber asked to arrive 2 days prior to boarding the riverboat.

An intensive week for MBA and master's-level students with work/internship experience, exclusively open to students from the 12 CoBS member schools.

























30TH JUNE - 5TH JULY, 2025: THE FGV EAESP-CoBS INTENSIVE WEEK IN THE AMAZON RAINFOREST, BRAZIL.

Theme: Sustainable Leadership: The rainforest perspective.

- This one-week, award-winning program (UN PRME 2024 Program & Faculty Teaching Awards) enables students to deconstruct the concept of leadership taught in mainstream management education by discovering the context, communities and stakeholders who inhabit the Amazonian rainforest.
- Travelling on a riverboat up the Amazon River to meet with indigenous, riverine and local entrepreneurs, participants observe and understand different perspectives of leadership, conceptualizing what it means to lead for sustainability
- Students observe and identify the systemic impacts and influences of decisions / actions of public, private and NGOs, as well as individuals, for local and global sustainability.
- This program enables participants to understand the importance of articulation and dialogue in the search for convergence of interests between the different actors involved in a given context.
- Students mobilize and carry out actions to incorporate sustainability into their reflections and practical actions.



Professor Fernanda Carreira, Academic Director and Field Trip organiser at FGV EAESP Period: 30th June-5th July with a mandatory online preparatory class one week before the trip.

Costs: €1.5K per student, including

- Flight from São Paulo to Santarém (Amazonia)
- Regional hoat
- Hotel in Tapajos region for the first and last nights
- Food and beverages
- Bus travel
- Taxes paid to the communities.

The trip is entirely operated by Community-Based Tourism, not only as a way of generating local income, but also to give a voice to the Amazonians, to the local population, so that we do not repeat a colonizing model of knowledge.

Important: Airfare from the students' country of residence to São Paulo, Brazil is to be either paid fully by the student, part-subsidized by the student's school, or fully integrated into the student's program tuition fees (depending on the student's home school policy)

Students should factor in 1 night hotel stay in Sao Paulo on the 29th June and 1 night on July 6th at their cost



ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

We seek and encourage students and participants with the following attributes to apply for the Advanced International Certificate:

Rigorous, open-minded, international in mindset, resilient, respectful of diversity, creative-innovative, ethical, action-oriented, objective, analytical, curious, enlightened, involved, solutions-oriented, willing to go the extra mile, quality-driven, professional in attitude and execution.

As a general guideline, students must already have completed classes in (either or all) marketing, management, strategy, and finance.

Students must be in good health to participate in the Amazon experience.

FOR MASTER'S STUDENTS WISHING TO FOLLOW ONLINE MODULES + BUSINESS SIMULATION + INTENSIVE WEEK:

You must be currently enrolled in a program at master's level in one of the CoBS member schools (see list on page 2).

Ideally, master's level students should have work or internship experience, demonstrate good grades throughout their academic journey in their home school, and show a passion for the areas the advanced international certificate covers.

You must provide a letter of motivation explaining your passion and interest for the CSR, ESG, Sustainability fields. What you understand by responsible leadership. Your career aspirations. Your work/internship experience. Your CV.

As a general rule, each school will approve participating students according to the minimum requirements each school will set for them.

FOR MBA PARTICIPANTS WISHING TO FOLLOW ONLINE MODULES + BUSINESS SIMULATION + INTENSIVE WEEK:

You must be currently enrolled in a program at MBA level in one of the CoBS member schools (see list on page 2).


You must have at least 4-5 years of full-time work experience and professional achievement.
